

2018 Mildura Writers Festival Residency Application

The Mildura Writers Festival invites writers working in any genre to propose a project that will enhance the regional or national cultural landscape. The residency will be located in Mildura, Victoria. Sitting on the edge of the Australian desert along the Murray River, Mildura is less than two hours drive from Mungo National Park within the World Heritage listed Willandra Lakes Region. The Mallee, extending beyond the South Australian and New South Wales borders is a region which has provided artistic inspiration to numerous writers, visual artists, filmmakers and musicians. In July of 2018, the Mildura Writers Festival will be celebrating its 24th anniversary. Beginning in 1995 in Stefano de Pieri's cellar restaurant, the Mildura Writers Festival has evolved into one of the finest literary festivals in the country, bringing together acclaimed Australian and International writers.

The Mildura Writers Festival Residency will take place from the 29 June to the 27 July 2018

With support from sponsors, Arts Mildura will provide the successful applicant with the following:

- Accommodation (within walking distance of the CBD) in Mildura for one month;
- Complimentary access to all Mildura Writers Festival events;
- Petrol vouchers for the return drive to Mildura, from Melbourne, Sydney or Adelaide, as well as any local driving that is deemed necessary (we regret that we are unable to cover airfares to and from Mildura);
- An honorarium of \$1000;
- Some sponsored meals by local restaurants.
- Access to local locations and community groups with the support of the Mildura Writers Festival.

During the Mildura Writers Festival Residency the successful applicant is expected to:

- Make significant progress on a project of his or her choice;
- Write up-to-date blog entries, organized by The Mildura Writers Festival Residency, based on the work and experience of the residency. The potential for this is unlimited and can include text, images or anything else that is appropriate;
- Host at least one workshop within the community (target audience and workshop programming to be determined by the successful applicant) before and/or after the Mildura Writers Festival;
- Attend the Mildura Writers Festival between 19 - 22 July 2018 as a special guest;
- The successful applicant will provide a signed agreement form for Arts Mildura and The Mildura Writers Festival to use the blog content and other provided materials for promotions, funding applications, media, etc;
- It is the successful applicant's responsibility to arrange travel to and from Mildura;
- Acknowledge the Mildura Writers Festival Residency in any published works developed during the Residency.

All applicants must provide:

- The completed application form
- A current CV and brief biography
- Necessary supporting materials (see application form)

Arts Mildura and the Mildura Writers Festival are committed to providing equal opportunity for all Mildura Writers Festival Residency applicants. All decisions will be made without consideration of race, gender, family status, age, sexual orientation, disability and religious or political beliefs.
